Port Executive Director Bob Hyde acknowledged a number of partners including the Community Economic Revitalization Board (CERB) of the state Department of Commerce. The project was funded by a Job

Development Fund (JDF) grant.

On hand representing the CERB Board was Lisa Wellman. Also present was Ginny Broadhurst, director of the Northwest Straits Commission, and Sally Harris from the Department of Commerce.

Project Manager Marc Estvold credited Port staff, citing in particular the contributions of Bob Elsner, Connie Thoman and Teri Switalski. Construction General Contractor was IMCO General Construction, Inc.
