

Cap Sante Boat Haven Group Reservations

Welcome to Cap Sante Boat Haven, a division of the Port of Anacortes. It is our intent to ensure your visit to Cap Sante Boat Haven is a pleasant and enjoyable experience.

Group Reservations are accepted for groups of FIVE (5) or more vessels. Moorage is charged at the current seasonal rate. There are no additional charges for group reservations. Group reservations are **NOT** available during special event dates. These special event dates are:

- 4th of July Weekend
- Anacortes Arts Festival – First weekend in August
- Labor Day Weekend – First Monday in September

All moorage is assigned on a “first come, first served” basis. Every effort will be made to keep vessels of the group together. However, there is no assurance that vessels can be grouped together due to variations in length and/or other factors.

A list showing the following information must be provided to the Harbor Office at least two (2) weeks prior to the group’s arrival date.

- each boater’s name, address and phone numbers
- vessel name and/or registration number
- vessel make and model
- vessel OVERALL LENGTH and beam
- date of arrival
- expected time of arrival, and
- length of stay

Each group must have a designated contact person who will be known as the Group Leader. The “Leader” must:

- 1) be the first one of the group to check into the Harbor Office;
- 2) maintain contact with marina staff during the group’s stay; and
- 3) check out with the Harbor Office at the end of the stay to verify all moorage has been paid.

The Group Leader and/or each vessel operator must confirm reservations with the Harbor Office by 1500 hours (3:00 p.m.) on the scheduled day of arrival. Reservations held past 1500 hours will be charged overnight moorage whether or not the vessel occupies the slip. Reservations canceled prior to 1500 hours will not be charged moorage.

Registration with the Harbor Office and payment of moorage is required upon arrival.

On the departure date, the Group Leader will verify with the Harbor Office the names and addresses of those who were “no shows” and did not cancel their reservations. Those individuals are responsible to contact the Harbor Office and arrange for payment of their reserved and unpaid moorage. (The marina will accept bankcard payments over the phone.)
